### **AN IQAC ACTIVITY**

Writing an innovative research proposal is an integral part of acquiring funds from

government funding agencies to target the unmet need of healthcare. BNCP organizes a

**RESEARCH GRANT WRITING COMPETITION** to assess, hone and develop the

writing skills of the students. Applications are invited from M. Pharm (1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> year students) and PhD students to showcase their writing skills. The faculty is also invited to participate. The themes of this competition are:

#### **Themes**

- 1. Diagnostic interventions in cancer, stroke, diabetes, vector borne disease, tuberculosis, leishmaniasis.
- 2. Target based therapeutic modalities in oncology.
- 3. Physical health related problems specifically related to women including heart diseases, breast and cervical cancer, osteoporosis, depression and autoimmune diseases.

#### **Evaluation** criterion

The proposals will be evaluated for adherence to the theme, novelty of the research proposal, extent of the literature survey, application of the concept and writing skills by an independent jury panel.

#### Format of the research proposal

The proposal should be submitted in the word document format with title, name of the authors followed with abstract (not more than 250 words), rationale, objectives, expected outcomes. The proposal should discuss in detail about the origin of the proposal, literature review (national and international), methodology and expected outcomes (in-detail).

#### Awards

The best research proposal will be awarded an amount of ₹10,000. The winners will be announced on the Annual day 2019.

Submission deadline: 28th January 2019

Note: The students can form a team of two (interdepartmental collaboration is encouraged).
