Activities in Dayitva:

The members of the cell along

with one volunteers participated in this event. In this manner, there were a total of nineteen students who attended the camp.

The place is truly a very motivating and filled with positive vibes. The blind people whom we interacted were much more enthusiastic and confident than us. Amongst them there were several dignities who are part of INDIAN INTERNATIONAL CRICKET TEAM for BLIND who have recently won the world cup for the country. Being blind has never stopped them from doing any task, they can dance, sing, play instruments, make candles, do jobs and much more which is beyond are imagination. The place is very serene and the people are very co-operative and helpful.

Motive:

Being a part of a cell whose motive is *Sensitivity / Motivation / Leadership*, it is our fundamental duty to respect the learning we get in the process and share the experiences and inculcate the same values and zest in the younger generation to do their bit for the society.

With the perspective of learning and sharing, our camp was inclined towards the blind people and our motive was to make them happy by spending time and interacting with them. Their outlook on life and optimism after facing various hardships are some of the qualities we need to inculcate in ourselves. Living lives with a new vision even with the darkness is something we learnt from them.

Sachin sir gave the entire information and guided us throughout the event to make it a grand success. Before initiating the session all the guests present at the blind home were introduced to Dayitva and addressed by the Rohil Desai and Hetvi. All the members were very enthusiastic and worked as a single unit in order to make this event a grand success that it turned out to be.

Activities:

The entire event was hosted by Hetvi and Rohil Desai. There were two major sessions in the event: Games session and Interactive session.

Games session –

This being the first session of the entire day, we had begun by taking name of Lord Ganesha.

And then the first game played was “Pehlio ko khel” in which almost 20 different riddles were asked to the audience to which the raised hands and answered the riddles. They were well mannered and behaved. On being asked they really enjoyed that round a lot and people loved wanted more of it but we running less on time had to move on with other games. The second game played was “Sangeet Khurchi” in which blind were divided in to two teams viz. Totally visually impaired and Partially visually impaired. There were three winners to each group and they were felicitated by Dayitva’s head coordinators.

We had to take a short informative break in which they were informed about various unknown facts which was addressed by Amey. They agreed to the facts and were happy to know something new and said we will surely implement this in our day to day lives.

Moving forward, the last game was “Kaun banega Bollywood Raja” and there were several winners to this round. All were quite well-versed with the bollywood news. At the end gifts were given to the winners.

Entertainment session –

After Games session, a short break was given where the KASHH BAND prepared themselves for the bang on performance that they gave. But before the Kashh band, Bhairavi sung a beautiful song “ASHAYEIN” to motivate our guests. Followed by Kashh band, they sang various of songs ranging from 1960-2017 songs, which our guests thoroughly enjoyed a lot. They were on top of their voices asking to perform one more time. One of the guests named Ajay Ji sung a melodious bhajjan. Kashh band got a lot of appreciation from the blind people and the last activity was we asked them to show their talent. Two of the guests played Tabla and Harmonium which had the most soothing tunes ever and though being blind it never seemed that as their weakness. One of the guest even danced to which we all were shocked and amused at such an amazing performance. It truly motivated all of us.

One of the guest gave speech where he referred DAYITVA as mom because we really made them felt happy and it touched our hearts. It gave us immense satisfaction knowing that you are the reason for someone’s happiness. Last but not the least, cake was cut and food was served to them. Celebration time it was.
