Game session-

We then started with game session with a Quiz. Which had two sections 1- “Kaun Banega Bollywood ki Queen” 2-“Sabse Smart Kaun.” Each correct answer would get a gift.

We then played our 2nd game which was based on Memory. Girls were divided into two groups. In this game girls had to memorize few words within one min which were displayed. They were then told to write it down on a sheet of paper within 1 min. The one with maximum corrected words was given a gift.

Musical session-

Andrew D’Souza and Rex Pereira played *guitar and sing songs* were invited to our event to make it more special and memorable one. As it truly said “*When words fail music speaks*”. Music session was enjoyed and liked by everybody. Finally it was their turn to showcase their talent some of them sang song, recited poem, jokes and dance also.
