Session Title-Workshop on Patents and Trademarks

Date- 10th January, 2019.

Time- 10:00am onwards.

The workshop on Patents and Trademarks was held by Dr. Bhanubhen Nanavati College of Pharmacy on 10th January, 2019. The workshop was hosted by Dr. Rashmi Mallya and the invited Guest speaker for the day was Dr. Alka Mehta who is a Co-Founder, ipEssentia (A law service Firm). She received Master's and Doctoral Degree in Pharmacy and pursued Post Graduate Diploma in Patent Law and Practice.

The workshop started with introductory remarks of Dr. Munira Momin., Principal of Dr. Bhanubhen Nanavati College of Pharmacy to enlighten students with her remarkable words.

Later, the host invited the speaker who guided the students about what exactly are Patents and Trademarks and how it is important to patent one's research and protect the acquired rights. A patent is a property right issued by a government authority allowing the holder exclusive rights to the invention for a certain period of time Negligence in filing the patent can led to legal issues. She then explained about Patents and Trademarks briefly.

Patents prevent others from making and selling an invention, but trademarks protects the words, phrases, symbols, logos or other devices used to identify the source of goods or services from usage of other competitors. To make the workshop more interactive, she asked examples of patents or trademarks they know, for how many years the patents are protected, what legal problems one can face if they neglect filling the patent. There was a question asked by a student that what is the procedure for filing a patent on which madam explained the whole procedure and stating that how maintaining all the records when one is working are important.

Further speaker explained about the term Attorney and how it is different from advocate which made it easy to understand the legal steps involved in same. Most patents are invalid because the inventions claimed in them are either disclosed by or rendered obvious by the prior art, and therefore fail one or both of the legal tests for patentability. Before concluding the workshop, the students were given opportunity to ask their questions to the speaker and she addressed them and also showed a small informative video on difference between patents, trademarks and copyrights.

There was a question asked by a student whether GST is involved by creating a patent then there was other question which said what can make your patent strong - A strong patent is often seen as one that is enforceable, a patent under which infringement can be found and which can withstand a test of validity. TM stands for trademark. The TM symbol (often seen in superscript like this: TM) is usually used in connection with an unregistered mark—a term, slogan, logo, or other indicator—to provide notice to potential infringers that common law rights in the mark are claimed.

Last but not the least the workshop ended with a small token of appreciation to the guest and the host thanked the speaker to enlighten with knowledge and the students for being a patient and interactive audience.
