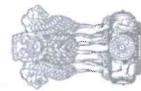

Round 1- The name of the round was Skribbl, where the contestants were given a brand name and they had to draw the logo or draw the hints so that other contestants could

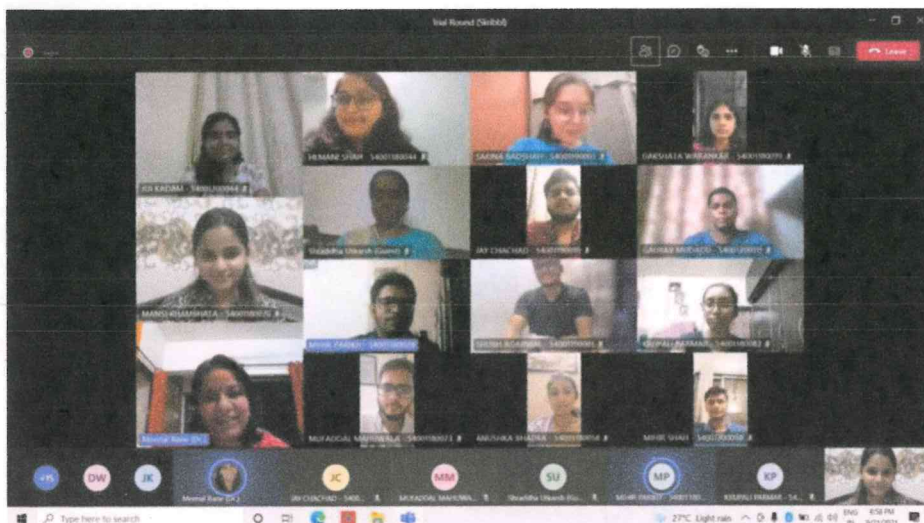
guess the word. The points were scored on the basis of drawing and guessing. Through this round we were able to judge them on the basis of creative thinking.

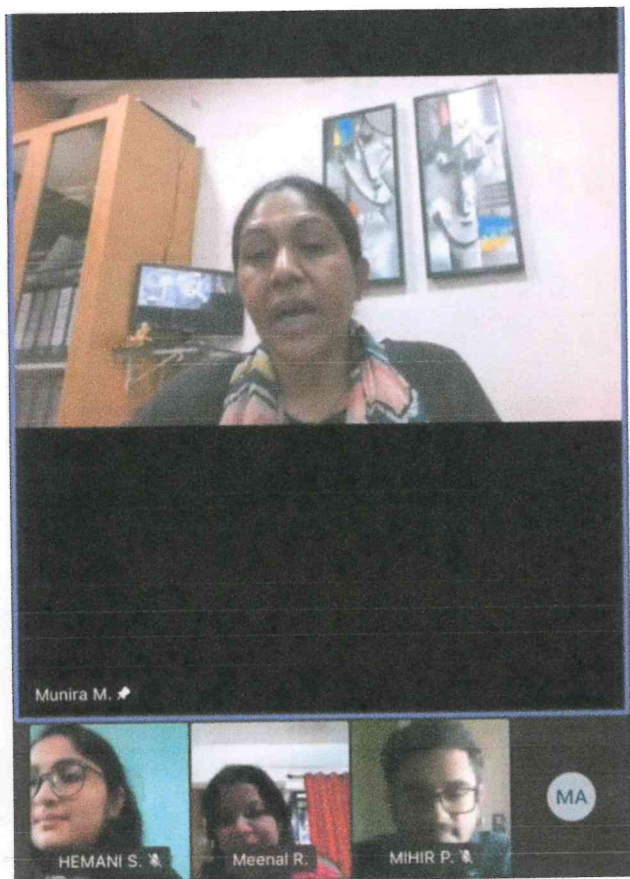



Inauguration of Innovation ambassador training program 2021 online session was conducted on 31st August 2021 via MHRD Innovation Cell YouTube channel. The session was started with an introduction of speakers by Mr. Udyan Maurya. Later Prof. Anil Sahasrabudhe addressed the inaugural session on innovation ambassadors and talked about how innovation has been inculcated as innovation ambassadors in various institutions from different fields, insights on Yukti 2.0 portal which helps in supporting women technical leads in their entrepreneurial start-up journey also help them to reach out in India as well as abroad. There are various opportunities provided by IIC innovation, MIC driven, and the support provided by AICTE towards innovation. Professor Sahasrabudhe further elaborated on the point of how ambassadors become mentors for the innovation which take place in the institute within students.

The first speaker of the day Dr. Abhay Jere (Chief Innovation Officer, MIC) briefed about various innovation and entrepreneurial initiatives of the ministry of education innovation cell for higher education institutes. He gave insights on policy framework which is called national innovation and startup policy for faculty and students which includes equity sharing, revenue sharing, IP sharing, and various sharing's that faculty and students can take while maintaining the balance between academics and startups and can take the positions accordingly. Further, he explained the role of innovation ambassador in an institute, and gave insights on ARIA ranking systems that is the Atal Ranking of Institutions on Innovation Achievements.

The second speaker for the day Mr. Deepan Sahu (Assistant innovation director, ministry of education Innovation cell) explained about the innovation number training program and highlighted the points about innovation ambassadors will strengthen the IIC Council. He gave a detailed information on major stakeholders in innovation and also talked about what is lacking in the ecosystem of higher education system and how to tackle them. The role of the IIC council is breaking of isolation, resource mobilization, and conducting the activities throughout the year by maintaining the ranking scores on the IIC portal by IIC driven, self-driven, or MIC driven activities. Later on, he gave a brief about how mentor and mentee program sessions take place for IIC institutions. The event started with opening remarks from a very renowned person, Dr. Sajeed Chandran who is PhD Director, Adv. Drug Delivery Research & IVIVC/ Biopharmaceutics, Lupin Ltd. (Research Park), Pune.

The first topic for the day was research. The speaker emphasized on importance of relevance of research and ways to conduct planned Investigation, being creative and innovative. The speaker described about "CREATIVITY" as the ability or quality displayed when solving unsolved problems and it is the most important human resource of all, followed by different types of creativity, its components and various stages of being creative. This was the 14th session conducted by top student innovators who were asked to share their journey and hardships from them to be shortlist in the top 10 innovators and entrepreneurs from NIC 2021. The host introduced every student and then gave them the floor to talk about their projects.

The live session started with Mr. Nandu Surendran. His startup- B aegis life sciences had come up with an idea called oncogenes. This product was a solution which was injected before the MRI scan. Using this product cancer could be detected at a very early stage. The team of B aegis had seen a couple of cancer patients who were only diagnosed at the latter stages which did not give enough time to save them, this is what generated the idea in the young minds. Later on, Mr. Nandu spoke of their achievements as well.

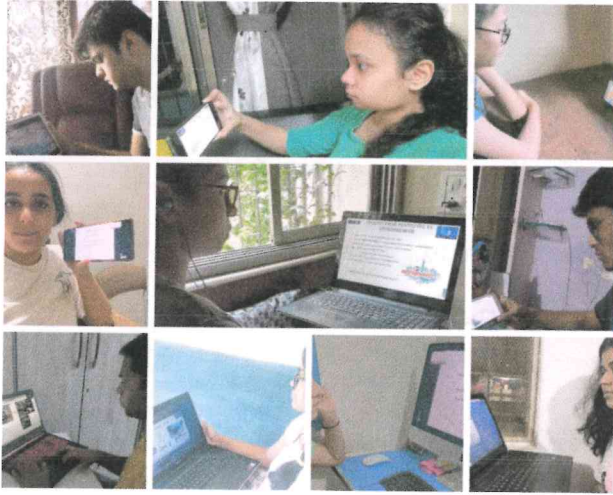
The floor was passed on to Mr. Sahil Uttekar who, along with his team Electrunk had a new project back in 2019. This idea revolves around using conventional and old scooter and Turk them into electric vehicles. Mr. Sahil spoke of his journey from prototype to entrepreneur. The team won NIC IIC MHRD and successfully secured the 2nd rank along with winning the AIT tech fest. They also have 2 research papers and 1 published journal on the same. The challenges they faced, like market survey and product development, were spoken by as well. Electrunk has a broad vision and has a clear future plan of receiving funds from AICTE/ government. Not only they plan on being approved by ARAI but also want to expand from scooters to 3,4-wheeler vehicles. Their supports include their mentors, various alumni and the entire E cell at AIT Pune.

Mr. Sandeep Vishwakarma continued and spoke of his project- Drishti. The problem statement was for visually impaired people. Drishti produces a smart glass that has various modes- walking mode, reading mode, google assistant and an SOS mode for emergencies. Drishti has a number of achievements, major one being the winner for national level COVID-19 hardware hackathon and securing the second position at atmanirbhar COVID-19 startup competition.

Mr. Harshal kotewar went next and spoke of the innovative swirl flow LPG burner head. This one was to increase the efficiency of a burner head. This way one could save 25 crore cylinders in 1 year. Mr. Harshal moved forward and spoke of the phases of competition followed by his own personal learning. These included- team leading, having a clear vision, marketing, project management, market research and the IP rights. The event was smoothly conducted and the host thanked all the young innovators and entrepreneurs for their time. The response was great during the live streaming as well.

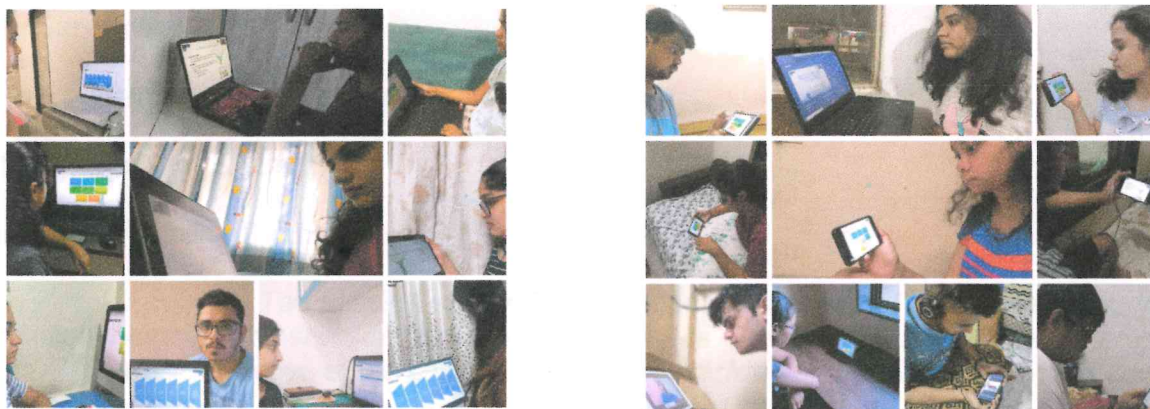
Generation and Management of IP at the early Stage of Innovation and Startup development online session was conducted on 6th September 2021 via MHRD's Innovation Cell YouTube channel. The session started with opening mark from Mr. Udyan Maurya (MHRD's Innovation cell member) and later introduced the speaker for the day, Dr. Sanjeev Majumdar , Manager,NRDC (Startup, IPR and Incubation) . To begin with Dr. Sanjeev gave a brief on innovation and ideas.

Dr. Sanjeev started the topic by discussing the basics of IP by covering its legal definition and explained the term property in terms of IP . During the session the role of IP in startups and business was made clear . He also included the need for IP protection in the aspect of marketing , profit , maintaining loyal followers , R and D etc . Further ,he described the types of Intellectual Property Rights and provided examples so that understanding can be made easy for the students. IP identification and management in startups / entrepreneurs was described in the terms of Do's and Don'ts .

Taking the session forward he explained the meaning of patent with its importance in startups and business. In addition he briefed about who can file a patent application in terms of various categories like legal representative of any deceased person , assignee, inventor and where to file a patent application . On top of that he included types of patent application in India and gave a gist on each type of patent application . What are the documents required for filing a patent application and details of application form like covering letter , abstract of the invention , information and undertaking , declaration of Inventorship etc. were covered in depth during the session , keeping the special focus on form filling , patent process and timeline . To conclude the speech he gave a quick information on technology transfer process and commercialization of IP.

The overall session was smoothly conducted and in the end session was open for students to ask doubts which were very well answered by Dr.Sanjeev.

The session started with the opening speech of Mr. Udayan Maurya (MHRD'S Innovation cell member). The speaker for the session was Ms. Prajakta Kulkarni (Co-founders, Nodes Pvt. Ltd., Pune). The main objective of the session was design thinking and how it is applied in education.

Next part of this session was more like an activity named as "sketch an ideal wallet" in which Ms. Prajakta asked us all to draw a perfect or an ideal wallet according to us. After that we were told to take opinion of the other person about their ideal wallet and sketch a wallet for them with a comparison test. Which gave us a thorough knowledge about design thinking. This activity represents

HCD (Hear, Create and Deliver) and why it is interconnected after that she gave us a brief about the characteristics of design thinking. Why one should use design thinking in order to execute their innovative idea was concluded by this session. The session was very informative and it was open for students to ask doubts and it ended on a thank you note.

After the presentation of Memes by all finalists the judges discussed the appropriate and most relevant meme to declare the winners of Round 3.

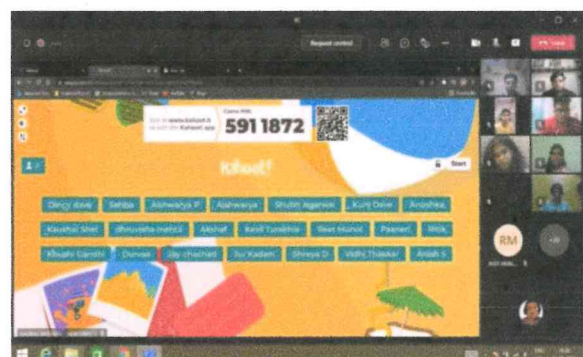

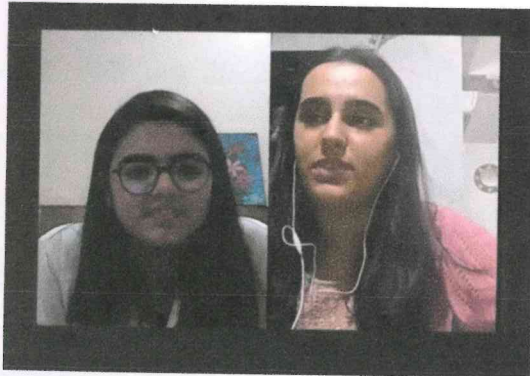


A peculiar event was also narrated by the interviewee where she had a major overlap of events but somehow managed to get her work done which taught her to react quickly and think faster.

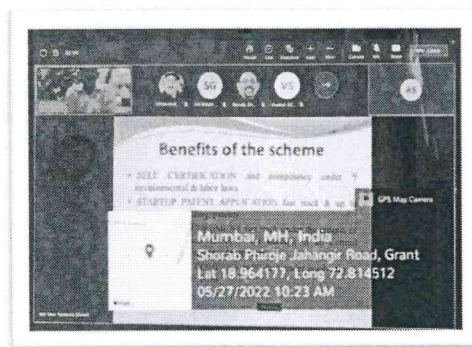
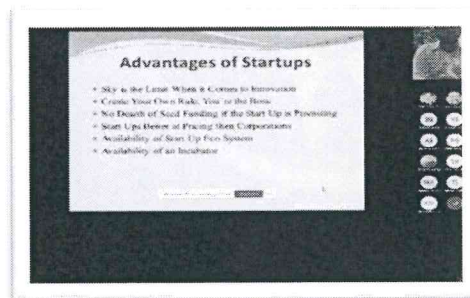
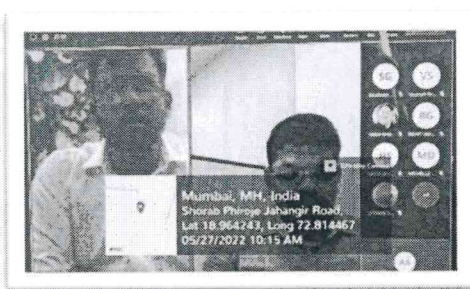
The session initiated with the inaugural remarks of Mr. Yasin khan (BNCP'S IIC committee general member) in which he also explained about the motto of IIC. The speaker for the session was Mr. Veer kankaria (Advocate, practice primarily in Bombay high court and supreme court) The topic of the workshop was startups in India: An overview and legal perspective.

Further he invited Dr. Sandip zine to enlighten us with few words. Then he briefly introduced Mr. Veer kankaria to the audience and also talked about some core areas practice by him. Mr. Veer started the session by briefing the topics which he was going to cover in the session. He began his discussion by defining entrepreneurship and said that the profit factor is very important in entrepreneurship. He then described startup and noted that it generally incorporates innovation that is not publicly available. Then, using an example, he distinguishes between entrepreneurship and startup. He also mentioned some of the benefits and drawbacks of starting a business. He even discussed briefly the many sorts of companies, including scalable startups, small company startups, lifestyle startups, buyable startups, large business startups, and social startups.

Moving on, he highlighted the Startups in India strategy, including its initiative, benefits, drawbacks, and eligibility. He also discussed the legal elements of several types of enterprises, such as sole proprietorship, partnership, limited liability company, and private limited company. Further he listed various documents required for startup india registration and gave idea about how to register for the same. Ahead in the session he discussed what are the steps incorporation of a startup. He said that first step is to formalized a business structure and founders agreement and it is essential to be clear about nature and type of business. Then there should be clear picture of what form of the business need to be incorporated then the second step is to apply for business licenses. Third is understanding taxation and accounting laws. Fourth and most important step before starting of any company or organization one should adheres to several labour laws. Fifth is ensuring protection of intellectual property. Sixth is ensuring effective contract management and lastly details about winding down the business. In which he said from legal standpoint, there are three ways: fast track exit mode, court or tribunal route and voluntary closure. He lastly discussed about the incubators, what are the eligibility criteria for incubators and impact of initiative on India.

Furthermore, the audience was invited to offer questions which the speaker answered thoroughly. Then Mr.Yasin khan invited Dr.munira momin(BNCP's principal) to say some words. At the end of session, the speaker was honored with the token of appreciation.

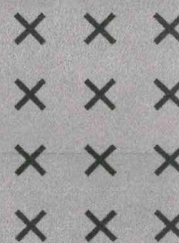

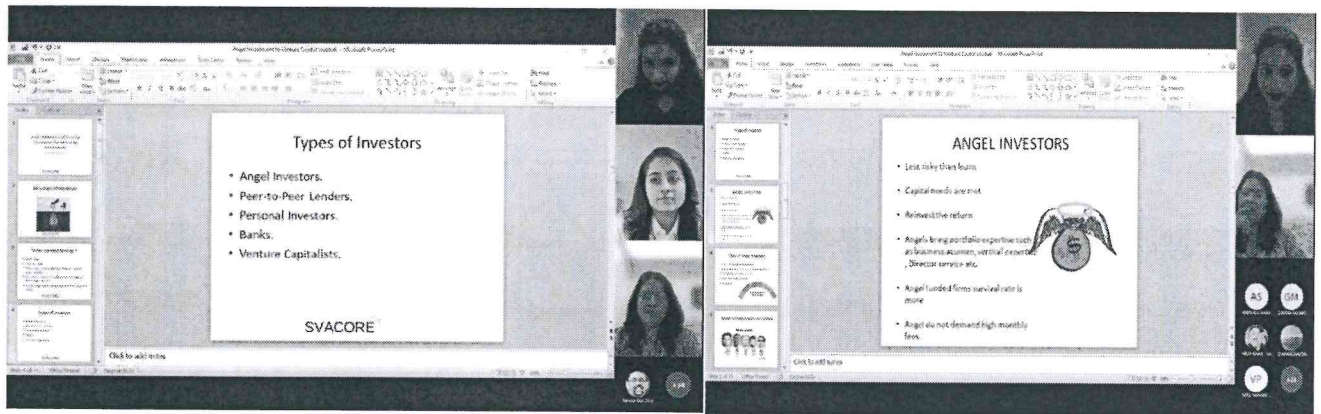
The session initiated with the inauguration remarks of Ms. Anushka Shah (General member of IIC). The speaker for the session was Ms. Vrushali Kulkarni (MBA Leadership and Speech Educator, Business Mentor). The main agenda of the event was to impart knowledge of angel investment and VC funding opportunities to early stage entrepreneurs.

Further Ms. Anushka Shah briefly introduced the speaker to the audience. Ms. Vrushali Kulkarni introduced the audience about what is early stage entrepreneurs. She then explained the kinds of investors and when do we need financing. Moving forward, she explained what angel are investors, why will angel investors invest, what they are looking for and what are the pros and cons of angel investors. She also talked about the possibilities of malpractices. After that, she talked about India's top investors like Dheeraj Jain, Kunal Shah, Ratan Tata, Anupam Mittal and Sandeep Tandon. Later in the presentation, she also explained how to approach venture capital, why we need venture capital and what does it mean along with its benefits and drawbacks. During the session, she spoke about the

difference between venture capital and angel investors. She also briefed about the different steps of venture capital like determining business valuation, determining funding need, putting ones pitch together then target potential investors, negotiate, proceed through due diligence and lastly close the deal. She finally told us about the user friendly sites where one can fit in its ideas by submitting project reports and getting a good help and shared resources of VCs.

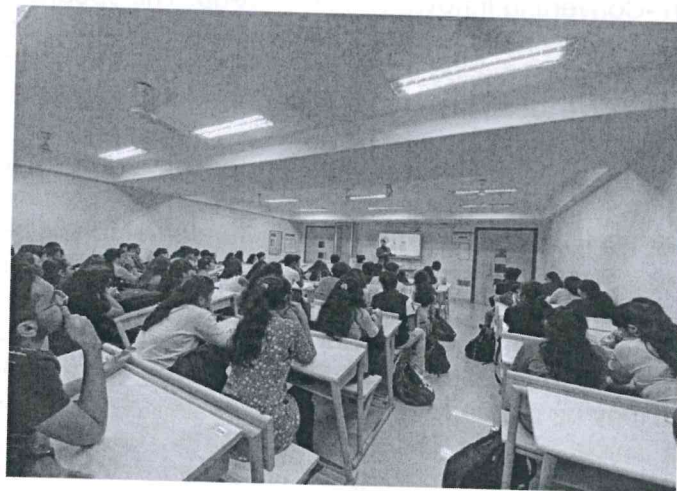
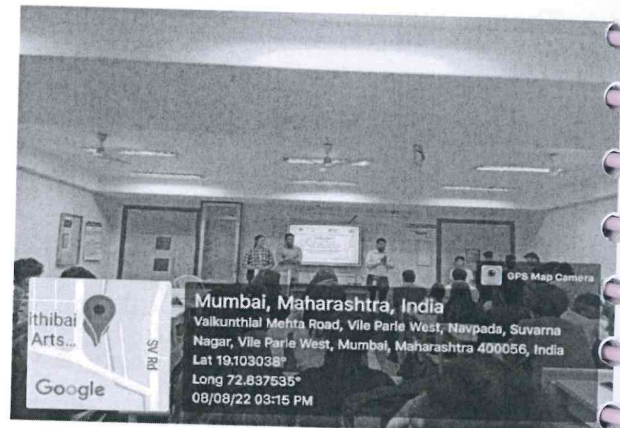
The Institute Innovation Council of Dr.Bhanubai Nanavati College Of Pharmacy conducted session on Innovation -Converting Innovation into start-up. The speaker for session was Mr.Ajay Raval (General Manager of Raymond Consumer Care). Ms.Dhwani Dawada (General Member of IIC) and Mr.Gaun Mudadu (General Member of IIC) hosted the event. The session focuses on giving broad idea about processes/using step for converting Innovative ideas into a social startup.

The session begins with welcoming address from the host followed by brief remarks from Dr.Sandip Zine (Chief Convener of IIC). He never gives up on his ability to succeed in life.

Further, The speaker showed the audience many TV commercials promoting Mr. Darshan Patel's inventions. He claimed that you can challenge multinational brands if you have a brilliant concept. Additionally, he listed the 10 traits that are crucial for success. He also explained how to obtain such significant investment from many types of investors, including angel and venture capital funding. In addition, questions from the audience were

The activity concluded with the students echoing the slogan 'Jai Hind Jai Bharat.'

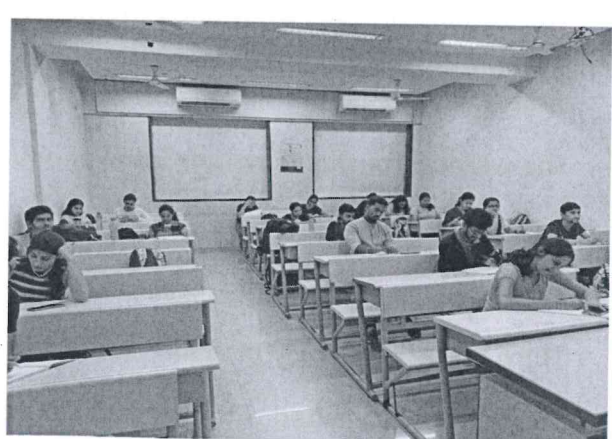
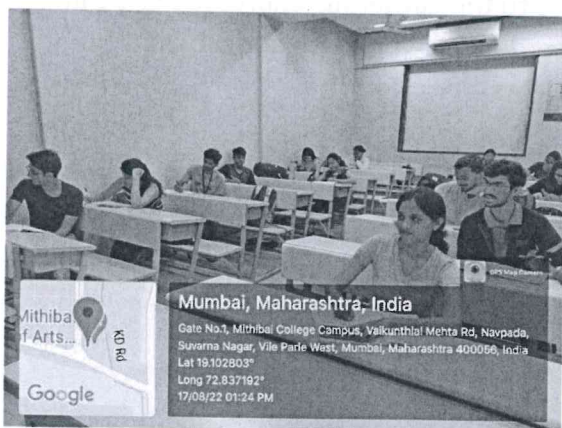
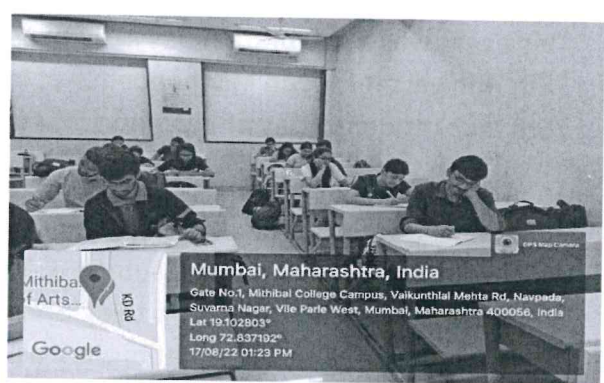
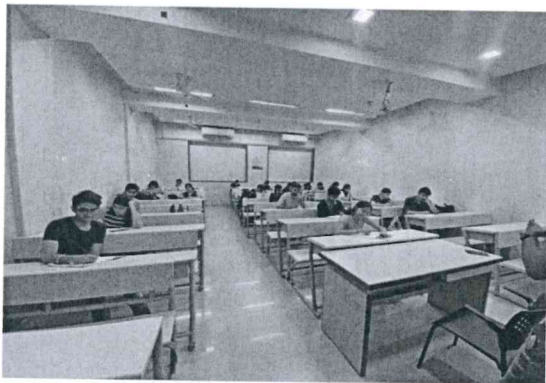

The students of Dr. Bhanuben Nanavati college of pharmacy were accompanied to the visit by Dr. Sandip Zine.

The session started with the introduction of the speaker and the attendees. Then the students were asked about their understanding for an incubation center. After listening to the answers, the speaker gave a brief introduction about what an incubation center is. Later the session proceeded with giving the attendees information about various subtypes of incubation which are: preincubation, physical incubation, virtual incubation and student faculty group. All these centers were explained thoroughly. The speaker also mentioned that the incubation center's major program is designed to help early-stage to mid-stage startups looking for a kick-start and connections. SP-TBI as an incubator will reach the start-ups and provide all these facilities remotely through our Virtual Incubation and Virtual Pre-incubation program. Moving on, there was a question answer session where the

students asked their queries. There was one major question that everyone had, how a person can enroll in such centers. The speaker briefly discussed the process for people who wish to display their ideas to visit their websites and register there. While registering, they should have a slight idea about their startup and some business terminologies. After the question answer session, there was a tour to their different laboratories. First one was the AR-VR lab followed by the 3D printing lab and the IOT lab. These labs help entrepreneurs to make models or carry out experiments related to their ideas.

The visit ended with a small conversation with higher officials who encouraged the students to develop an entrepreneurial mindset and visit such incubation centers in future.

To conclude with, the winners were announced based on the creativity. The winners for competition were as follows: -

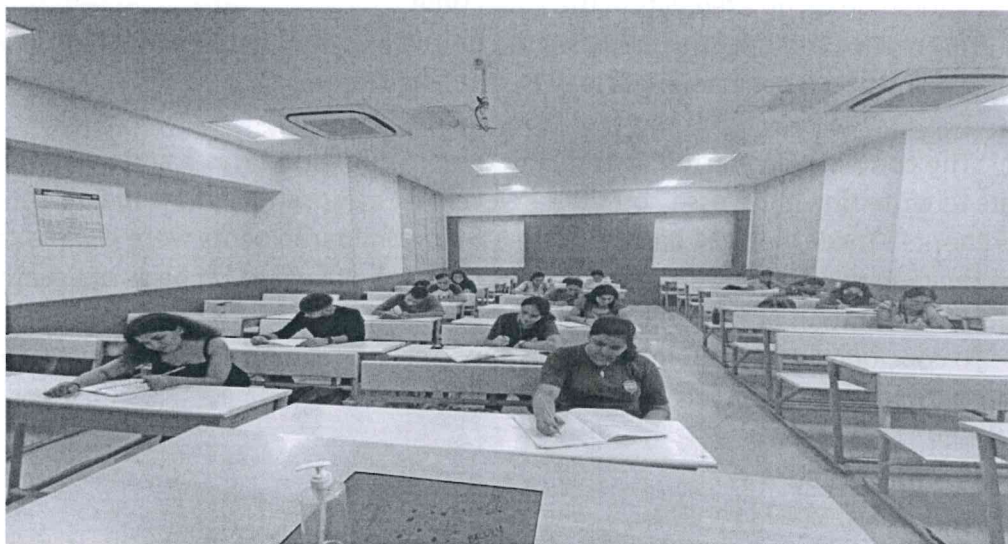
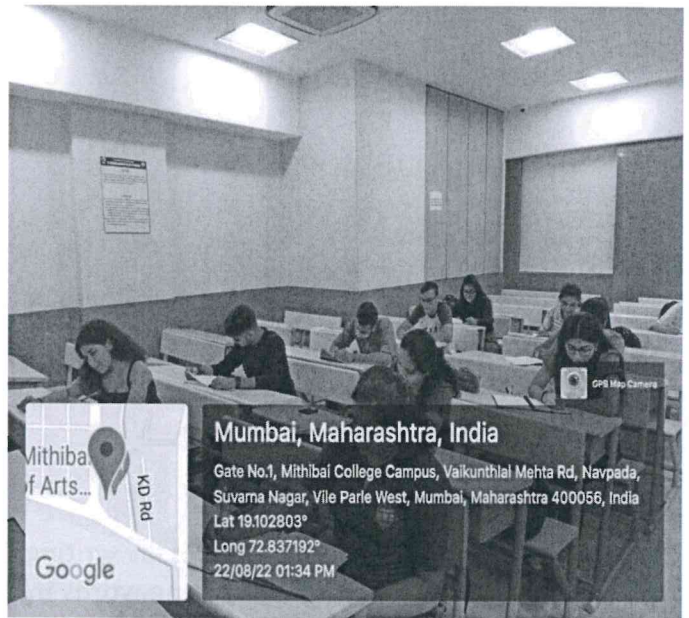
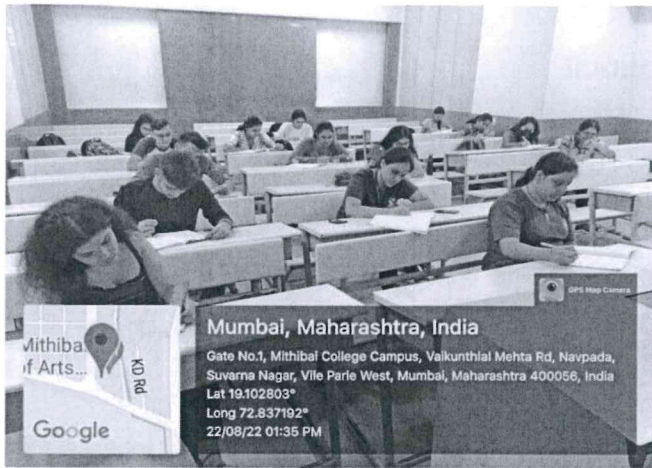

Dr. Munira Momin in the last six months has 2 patents filed and 2 that have been granted for her innovation in the field of novel antifungal composition and a curcumin hydrogel sponge for wound healing. Dr. Prabha Singh, the internship coordinator of IIC has been granted a patent for her innovation in the field of floating microporous osmotic tablets. Haardi Patel, the social media coordinator along with her group won the poster presentation that was one of the events in Ebullience in college for their innovative research. IPA had organized 'Brand Yourself' which involves promoting and marketing strategy for a product. Gaurav Mudadu and Dhvani Dawda, the general members of IIC had participated and were also one of the winners.

G) Few selected Best Innovations and images

The "Parishodhana-an Industry Defined Problem" event was organized by the IIC council of the Dr. Bhanuben Nanavati College of Pharmacy. The event's major goal was to provide pharmacy students a stage on which to present their innovative concepts and to foster the problem-solving abilities necessary for a successful entrepreneurial journey.

The following are some of the best innovators who participated and won:

Team No. 1- Kunjal Somaiya, Shreyl Dsouza , Zalak sheth, Ishaan Shah (1st Winner).

The team offered an Innovative answer for how humidity affects the production of products based on wet granulation, as well as a plan for mitigating the problem and explaining how it would be advantageous for a business financially.

Miscellaneous Solutions

- Increasing the quantity of disintegrant.
- Decreasing the quantity of binder.
- Increasing drying time to compensate the excessive humidity in the environment
- Reducing particle size to enhance dissolution by passing the granules through sieves.
- Maintaining good warehousing practices to ensure quality of raw materials and final products.

Team No. 2- Turabali Aminali Bana, Bharti Gupta, Darshana Sakpal, Jayesh Gupta (2nd Winner). The group provided a solution for disguising the taste of formulations as well as a cheaper excipient than sucrose. The goal was to give the industries better and more affordable alternatives.

Summary of solutions for the objectives

For objective 1	For objective 2
Instead of sucrose artificial sweetener like sucralose can be added which is suitable for Diabetic patients.	Aluminium foil sachet can be replaced with blister package if Dissolving tablet is formed instead of granules.
Instead of sucrose drug can be complex with the HP- β -Cyclodextrin which act as a taste masking agent and solubility enhancer.	In 1 blister package 10 DT tablet can be added which again reduces the cost of the formulation.

Team No. 3 - Gargi Dixit, Ruchita Gharat, Manshi Patel, Nikita Pise (3rd winner). The group offers an innovative method for businesses to reduce or eliminate with sugar, whose high concentration prevents diabetics from using it. They also provide alternatives to sucrose.

Conclusion

- Cost of the product can be reduced by:
- Using cheaper alternatives for aluminium like cellulose or metallic PEI as packaging materials.
- High contents of sucrose can be reduced by:
- Using less quantity of alternative sweeteners like sucralose
 - Taste masking by other formulation techniques like granulation, salt formation, effervescent formulation

H) IIC BNCP aiding start-ups

IIC (Institute Innovation Council) has been a part of Dr. Bhanuben Nanavati College of Pharmacy for almost 2 years now. And in these 2 years IIC has inspired young minds of BNCP to dive in the sea of entrepreneurship. It has groomed all those who are budding entrepreneurs with guidance with respect to legal formalities, professional development skills and some more. Students have highly started prioritizing being a part of IIC and its activities because it makes us believe that "Grooming your hobbies lead to sweet success".

IIC BNCP has 2 groups of 3 students under their guidance who are in pipelines of budding startups. The guidance provided to the budding entrepreneurs is from scratch including the budget, investments, profits and some other concepts that are essential for an entrepreneur. Apart from these concepts, it has also introduced the buds to the schemes that Government Of India provides to all those who wish to have their startups.

All in all ,IIC BNCP has always been a great support and guide to all the students who wish for a bright future for India with their innovation and skills.

I) Breakthrough innovations

IIC Council of Dr. Bhanuben Nanavati College of Pharmacy organized an enthusiastic event called PARISHODHANA on 5th of April 2022. In which many students got a platform to showcase their innovation skills. The event was judged by Dr. Prabha Singh, faculty of BNCP and Mr. Shripad Marathe, a pharmaceutical research and development professional currently working at Cal Scientific pvt ltd. Students participated as a team of four and solved the problem statement given to them.

TEAM 16 – Kunjal Somaiya, Sheryl Dsouza, Zalak Sheth, Ishaan Shah identified the problem for a wet granulation-based product whose manufacturing was shifted from Europe to Visakhapatnam in august. For which they stated that the root cause was humidity and gave an out-of-the-box migration plan which included employment of the humidity removal, choose an inlet air temperature to negate weather effect, bypass loop and dehumidifying the air to a present dew point.

Another formulation problem was solved by TEAM 14- Turabali Aminali Bana, Bharti Gupta, Darshana Sakpal, Jayesh Gupta. The main objectives of the problem were reducing/eliminating the use of sucrose for diabetic patients and reducing cost of product, for which the major factor was the use of aluminum sachets for packaging. They suggested the use of alternative sugars like sucralose and changing the formulation from dispersion to tablet. So, the price of the product can be greatly reduced by using conventional packaging technology for tablets. Same formulation problem was given to TEAM 2 – Gargi Dixit, Ruchita Gharat, Manshi Patel, Nikita Pise. They suggested different approaches for packaging like cellulose-based polymers and metallized PET film packs
