New Initiatives by College (IQAC Activities)

1. One-Day Workshop on "3D Printing of Pharmaceuticals" with a hands-on training session on 30/01/2026 (No. of participants: 72)

One-Day Workshop on "3D Printing of Pharmaceuticals" with a hands-on training was successfully organized in association with 3DFying, Hyderabad for students and faculty members of the institute along with students from other pharmacy colleges. The session was led by Dr. Prakash Katakam (Founder, 3DFying) and Dr. K. Shanta Kumari (Co-Founder, 3DFying) who shared valuable theoretical insights and live demonstrations on how additive manufacturing is transforming pharmaceutical product development. Dr. Prakash Katakam demonstrated 3D printing of pharmaceutical films and microspheres, while Dr. K. Shanta Kumari elaborated on applications in biologics, tissue engineering, and regenerative medicine. The workshop received an overwhelming response, with highly encouraging feedback from participants.



2. One-day workshop on Dissolution Testing: Principles, Practices and Real-World Applications on 18/03/2026 (No. of participants: 60)

In association with Sotax. India Pvt Ltd, a one-day workshop on Dissolution Testing: Principles, Practices and Real-World Applications was organized. The workshop included insightful session by Dr. Suhas Yewale (Associate Director, Techno Commercial, Sotax India Pvt. Ltd.) and Prof. Umesh Banakar (Professor and President, Banakar Consulting Services, USA) on advanced concepts in dissolution science. Dr. Suhas Yewale discussed the USP Type IV Flow-Through Cell Dissolution Apparatus, its comparison with USP Type I and II, and the concepts of open-loop and closed-loop systems. Prof. Umesh Banakar explained the relationship between K_1 (in vivo dissolution), K_2 (absorption), and K_3 (in vitro dissolution) in establishing IVIVC, highlighting the complexity of dissolution testing with multiple influencing factors. It was a valuable learning experience in understanding how dissolution studies help predict in vivo drug performance.

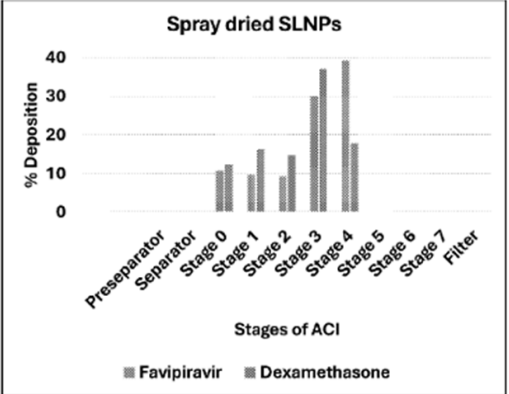

Instead, I enrolled in a Master of Pharmacy programme at my alma mater, trying to convince myself that this was the end of my research ambitions! Looking back, I realise that this rejection was, in fact, a blessing in disguise.
